ANSWER.

According to a confidential report received at this Office, the above named trawler is stated to have stranded one mile southwest of Gourdon on the 4th ultimo. She had a heavy list to starboard, three feet of water were in the engine room and she was high and dry at low water.

As no further information on the case has been received at this Office, I shall be glad if you will be so good as to ascertain and let me know whether she has been refloated, repaired and replaced in commission, or abandoned as a total loss by all concerned.
