
Dear Sirs,

I have to acquaint you that reports have been received from the Society's Surveyor at Calcutta on the steamers "TAIREA" and "TAKLIWA", built in 1924 by Barclay, Curle & Co., Ltd., for the British India S.N. Co., Ltd.

These sister vessels are engaged in the coastal service of the B.I. Co. and examination has disclosed defects in the oil fuel bunkers. and double bottom tanks in the engine and boiler space used for carrying oil.

The steamer "TAIREA" is now reported to be at Bombay where repairs are to be undertaken, and in view of the importance of the case the Builders are sending out two Representatives for the purpose of dealing with the matter.

In the circumstances it has been arranged with the Owners that the Society should send a Senior Surveyor to join the local Surveyor at Bombay in the survey of the vessel, and I have to confirm my telegram this evening as below, requesting that Mr. Cheetham will be good enough to proceed to Bombay for the purpose.
