Dear Sir,

S. I am in receipt of your letter of the 1st instant, enclosing one from Dr. Montgomerie reporting the result of his discussion with the Builders concerning the scantlings of the oil fuel tanks in the steamers "TAIRBA" and "TAKLIWA", and have to confirm my telegram this afternoon as follows:-

"PLEASE OBTAIN AND FORWARD DUPLICATE BLUE PRINTS
SHOWING ADDITIONAL STRENGTHENING PROPOSED TAIRBA"

It is noted that the proposals of the Builders are made with the object of preventing a recurrence of the trouble which has been experienced in these tanks, and that Dr. Montgomerie has been careful to impress upon the Builders that any suggestions made by him do not commit the Committee in any way.

It is also observed from the remarks on the photoprints enclosed with your letter of the 2nd instant that these plans refer only to the "TAIRBA".
