Dear Mr Scott,

Dr Montgomery your man in Glasgow came to see me today and said Sir Thomas Storey thought it would be better for Lloyds to send a man out to see "Tairea" as the builders were sending out two men by "Rawalpindi" leaving Marseilles on 4th. I agreed at once and telegraphed to our Passenger Manager in London, Mr F.Grosvenor at Cockspur Street:-

"Can you possibly fit in a surveyor Lloyds to "Bombay in "Rawalpindi" He might go if necessary "into second class cabin transferring into first "at Port Said very urgent".

This evening I have his reply

"Can arrange for Lloyds Surveyor as suggested"

If you will communicate with Mr Grosvenor the accommodation will be arranged. I am sending a copy of this note to Mr Hamilton, Secretary of the British India Co., with whom you have been in communication, and also a copy to Mr Grosvenor.
