Dear Dr. Montgomerie,

I am in receipt of your telegram as follows:-

"LORD INCHCAPE AGREES SURVEYOR BEING SENT STOP HE HAS
"TELEGRAPHED HIS LONDON OFFICE RESERVING BERTH
"RAWALPINDI SAILING LONDON THURSDAY NEXT".

In the circumstances Mr. Cheetham of the Leith Office has been instructed by telegram to proceed to Bombay, leaving London on Thursday next, for the purpose of joining the local Surveyor in the survey of the "TAIREA".

Mr. Cheetham has also been requested in the same telegram, (which I hope will reach him tonight) to attend at the Glasgow Office tomorrow, Saturday, for the purpose of going over the papers of the "TAIREA" and "TAKLIWA" with you, and the Deputy Chairman thinks you may consider it desirable to call in Mr. Clark, under whose survey the vessels were built, so that he may furnish any particulars that may be necessary.

You probably have copies of the plans in the Office, and I enclose the first entry reports on the vessels, together with the documents and correspondence relating to the cases. Perhaps you will be so good as to

The Deputy Chairman further states that it might be well for Mr. Cheetham to see the Builders, and if there is another vessel under construction in the Glasgow district with similar arrangements to those in the two B.I. boats, he suggests that Mr. Cheetham might go down with you and see it.

Mr. Cheetham will be calling at this Office before leaving for Bombay, and any further points which it may be desirable to discuss can be dealt with then.
