

SUGGESTED TELEGRAM TO DR. MONTGOMERIE

Some time back we made an offer to Lord Inchcape that we should send out a first class Ship Surveyor to India to superintend the repairs to the TAIREA and TAKLIWA the Surveyor to be sent entirely at the cost of the Society nothing to be debited to the British India. Lord Inchcape declined the offer. We now learn that the Shipbuilders are sending out two of their most important men, and in these altered circumstances we should prefer to send one of the Society's Senior Surveyors to Bombay for the purpose of supporting the local Surveyor. In view however of Lord Inchcape having declined the Committees offer previously it is thought well as a matter of courtesy to apprise him of the Committees views, and it is desired you will interview Lord Inchcape who we understand is at Glenapp and ascertain whether he has any objection
