

S.S. "TAIREA" & "TAKLIWA".

Captain Penny, Assistant Superintendent of the British India Steam Navigation Company, called at this Office this morning in connexion with the case of the "QUERIMBA", and he was asked the position in regard to the "TAIREA" & "TAKLIWA".

He stated that it had been decided that the ships should be repaired at Bombay, the "TAIREA" having already left to dry-dock at that port on the 18th October and will be ready to dry-dock today. The dry dock has been reserved for three months, and on completion of the repairs to the "TAIREA" the "TAKLIWA" will follow.

Captain Penny is not aware whether the Builders are sending out an Official especially for the work. It is understood that the representative of the Builders' firm who was in Calcutta at the time of the survey of the "TAIREA" was on a voyage round the world at the time.
