

s.s. "TAIREA"

The Glasgow letter forwards no fresh information except that the "TAKLIWA" and "TAIREA" appear to have been built in different yards of the same Builders, although from the returns the vessels are given as having been built at Whiteinch, and they were both surveyed by the same Officer during their construction.

The "TAIREA" was surveyed in Calcutta by the most capable Ship & Engineer Officers of the Society available, there being no Ship Surveyor stationed in India.

If it is desired that these vessels be examined by a Ship Surveyor, it is thought that a Surveyor of wide experience should be sent from this country, and in such circumstances it is suggested Mr. Sneddon would be suitable.
