Sir,


I beg to confirm the following cablegram sent to you
 to-day :-

EDACHEFWIP	= Arrived here
EFOBIEWLRE	= from Calcutta
FAXYB	= 2nd October.

from which you will see that I have resumed duty here
 after my visit to Calcutta in connection with the s.s. "TAIREA".
 I hope to forward by next week's mail my arrears of reports and
 financial returns.

The length of time taken on the survey of the s.s.
 "TAIREA" was due to the time taken to clean and steam out the
 oil tanks for the thorough internal examination of same. I shall
 forward my expenses on this case by next week's mail. You would
 see from one of our communications from Calcutta that the s.s.
 "TAKLIWA" had sailed prior to my arrival there. She is expected
 back in Calcutta in about two months' time. As the object of my
 visit to Calcutta was to survey this vessel also, for reported
 defects similar to those which have arisen in the s.s. "TAIREA".
