With reference to your cablegram reading as follows:-

"Houston Bombay instructed join you immediately survey "TAIREA" and "TAKLIWA" and cable fully joint report explaining whether stated defects in double bottom and bunkers necessitate dry-decking and for how long in Calcutta or Home port. Do not render account meantime."

Mr. Houston arrived yesterday evening and this morning we have made a survey of four of the oil fuel bunkers internally, and steehold tank top under pressure of the s.s. "TAIREA". Other tanks and bunkers are being prepared. A detailed cablegram will be sent on completion of survey ^{which} we anticipate will be finished in about a week's time.

The s.s. "TAKLIWA" sailed yesterday for China and will be surveyed on her return.
