



In accordance with instructions, I called on Mr. Hamilton, the Secretary of the British India Steam Navigation Co., in regard to the cases of the steamers "TAIREA" and "TAKLIWA". Mr. Hamilton stated that he was quite agreeable to instructions being sent to the Bombay Surveyor to join the Calcutta Surveyor in the survey of these vessels, as the Company is much concerned at the report which they have received. From this report it would appear that there are considerable structural defects in the vessels and that it is thought they will have to be sent from Calcutta to the Builders' yard, with a view to these defects being remedied.
