Babcock & Wilcox Ltd., Renfrew, attend at their Works on the 13th May 1926 and subsequent dates, for the purpose of testing and examining one pair of solid drawn superheater headers (their No. 12/21702) to the order of Messrs. T. Sugden Ltd., London, and intended for Messrs. John Brown & Co's No. 507.

Test pieces were stamped on the headers and the headers were examined under 400 lbs. per square inch hydraulic pressure and found, so far as could be seen, sound and free from defects.

Results of tests:-

Tensile.	Elongation.	Bend.
27.0 ^{tons} per sq. inch.	30 per cent in 4 inches.	180°
