With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamer "DYNAMO", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have now had before them the report of survey recently held at Hull, from which it is noted that the requisite General Examination was satisfactorily carried out except that several insulation faults were found in the electrical system.

In the circumstances it is not proposed to assign a notation of "Examined 2,43" in respect of the survey until the electrical installation is placed in order, and I shall be obliged if you will endeavour to arrange for this matter to receive attention as soon as possible without delaying the ship.
