With reference to Mr. Williamson's call at this Office on the 18th ultimo, regarding the new Steamer "~~DYNAMO~~", I beg to acquaint you that I have been in communication with the Society's Surveyors at Barrow, on the subject of the blind hole in the outside plating behind the margin angle, which was observed just prior to the launch of the vessel.

In reply, the Surveyors state that in their opinion the recommendation contained in their letter to your good selves of the 12th ultimo, viz., that the vessel be placed in drydock before completion, to enable the above matter to be attended to, should be carried out in order to the classification of the steamer and the issue of the Certificates in due course.
