Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of Mr. Shute's letters of the 13th and 14th instant, respecting the case of the steamer "DYNAMO", Messrs. R. Williamson & Son's No. 230, and with regard thereto I have to request that you will state definitely if you are of opinion that the vessel may be recommended for classification subject to a hole being drilled through the margin angle, and a rivet fitted through the hole in the outside plating and the margin angle, at the first dry-docking, or if you consider that the classification of the ship and the issue of certificates should be deferred until this rivet has been fitted.
