
Dear Sir,

I have to acquaint you that it appears from a First Entry Report received from the Society's Surveyors at Barrow that the new Steamer "DYNAMO", built by Messrs. R. Williamson & Son of Workington, Yard No. 230, has proceeded to your port where the machinery is to be placed on board, and to complete the survey the following work requires to be done, namely:-

- Loose work to rivet up and complete.
- Stern tube flange on aft peak bulkhead to make watertight.
- Winches and capstan to fit.

I shall be glad if the Surveyors will give the case the necessary attention and forward a report on Form 8 in due course when the survey has been completed, with a view to the classification of the vessel.
