Vessel placed on Renfrew Slip, the bottom, keel and rudder examined. Rivet hole in starb. bottom plating in way of aft end of margin angle drilled and rivet put in. A number of rivets in abbing piece on port & starb. side hardened up and made tight. Engine and Boiler Casings where left loose for shipment of machinery, packed, riveted up and tested. Winches and Capstan fitted and deck tested in way of holding down bolts. Windlass tested on trial and found satisfactory.
