With reference to your E. letters of 30th of March and 24th of April respecting the plan of general pumping arrangement proposed for Messrs. Wilton-Fyenoord's Yard No. 669, I have to inform you that the pipes No. 108 and 109 for draining No. 5 hold are connected to the tunnel bilge main.

The No. 4 double bottom tank is intended to be used for ballast tank.
