I am returning to you under separate cover one copy of the plan, advised in your letter of the 24th instant, of General Pumping Arrangement proposed for Messrs. N.V. Wilton-Fyenoord's Yard No.669, and have to inform you that this plan will be approved, provided the arrangements be as shown and amended thereon and the remaining requirements of Sections 34 and 40 of the Rules (1938-9) be complied with so far as they are applicable.

It is concluded that pipes Nos.108 and 109 for draining No.5 hold are connected to the tunnel bilge main, but I shall be glad if you will confirm this. Further, a sketch showing arrangement of copper plugs in drain pipes Nos.100, 101, 108 and 109 should be submitted for consideration.

I have to add that if No.4 double bottom tank is intended to be used as a dry tank the suctions should be led to the main bilge line and not to the ballast line.
