I duly received your letter of the 28th ultimo, advising amended plans (in duplicate) of shafting proposed by Messrs. N.V. Werkspoor for Messrs. N.V. Wilton-Fyenoord's Yard No.669, and with regard thereto I have to inform you that with triple expansion steam reciprocating engines having particulars as stated in my letter of the 27th February 1939, the amended plans of crank shaft and straight shafting will be approved, it being noted that dowel pins will not be fitted to the crank shaft, and I have to say that with the proposed yield point of the crank web material and shrinkage allowance this is in order.

One set of the amended plans is being returned under separate cover and I may say that the plans previously approved have been cancelled.
