We have your favour of the 1st inst., ref. H. in regard to this vessel. She is at present engaged in a series of tows for the Ministry of War Transport to and from Holland, under the auspices of SHAEF, for the relief and rehabilitation of the inundated island of Walcheren. We have been informed that this work is considered to be of great urgency, and have been asked to try and keep the tugs engaged in it, going, while it lasts, which should be another couple of months.

In view hereof, we are very anxious to avoid vessel being taken out of service for the purpose of the General Examination and Boiler Survey, which might involve considerable delay, and we should be obliged if you would give the matter your consideration and, if possible, meet us, and incidentally thereby meet the wishes of the authorities referred to in the above.
