
We have for acknowledgement your two communications dated 24th November, advising us that the annual General Examination of the tugs "DONAU" and "SEINE" will require to be held before the end of January next.

With regard to the "DONAU" this tug is at present at Swansea undergoing repairs, and we are requesting our Superintendents Messrs. Harte Lindley & Co., to get into touch with your local representative, and in conjunction with him to hold the Annual General Examination at the same time.
