Sir,

Reverting to your letter of the 3rd instant in regard to the Boilers made by Messrs. Babcock & Wilcox Ltd. and fitted on board the Steamer "WAR FIG" (The Monmouth S.B. Co's No. 368 vessel), I beg to acquaint you that I am now informed by Messrs. Babcock & Wilcox that the fee for the survey of these boilers is payable by the Ministry of Shipping, and I shall be glad to learn whether in these circumstances you will arrange for the account to be collected.

I think it well to explain that although these boilers were originally commenced as No. 434, parts of the original 434 and parts of 497 boilers were used in the construction, and the number 497 was given to the boilers after they left the Makers' works and it is therefore probable that they will be recognised by this number in the records of the Ministry of Shipping.


