With reference to your first entry report No. 4572 on the Turbines made by Messrs. Metropolitan-Vickers Electrical Co., I have to inform you that these turbines are reported by the Society's Surveyors at Newport, Mon., to have been fitted into the s.s. "WAR FIG", Messrs. The Hornmouth Shipbuilding Co's No.368 vessel.
