With reference to your letter to us of the 26th instant in connexion with the above contract calling for our remarks regarding fees, we have to state that £17 (inclusive of travelling expenses) together with the stipulation that the fees for the oil engines is exclusive of any fees and expenses in connexion with work which may be subcontracted by the Brush Electrical Engineering Co. Ltd., elsewhere, is the very minimum at which this work can be undertaken.


In the past fees have been reduced for a number of engines on condition that as many parts as possible of these engines were presented for inspection together, thus cutting down the number of visits necessary, and it is only in view of the fact that there is a possibility of more work at Messrs.
