I duly received your letter of the 23rd ultimo, advising plans (in triplicate) of Starting Air Receiver and Fuel Oil Tanks proposed for Messrs. A/S Burmeister & Wain's Maskin-og Skibsbyggeri's Yard No.646, and with regard thereto I have to inform you as follows:-

Air Receiver.

The plan of riveted air receiver will be approved for a working pressure of 25 kg. per sq.cm., provided the air receiver be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

Fuel Oil Tanks.

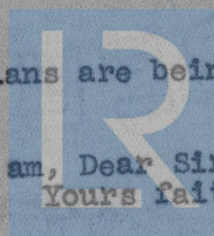
The plan showing arrangement and details of Fuel Oil Tanks will be approved, provided additional stiffeners be fitted in way of the tank bottom plating as now shown in red on the plan, or alternatively, the thickness of this plating be not less than 8.5 mm., and the whole of the work be carried out under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

Two sets of the plans are being returned under separate cover.
