With further reference to the Secretary's letter E dated 27th ultimo in respect of automatic sounding gauges to the double bottom tanks under the refrigerated holds intended for Messrs. Burmeister & Wain's Yard No. 646, we have to-day under separate cover forwarded for the consideration of the Committee plan and description, in triplicate, of the proposed sounding gauges which are made by Messrs. Metro, Aarhus, Denmark.

Also plan, in triplicate, showing arrangement of automatic sounding gauges to the double bottom tanks of Messrs. Burmeister & Wain's Yard Nos. 639, 640, 641.

In the case of the 2 latter ships, it is the intention to omit the ordinary sounding pipes.

We should be glad to be informed for our information if these automatic sounding gauges may be used also in the case of daily service oil fuel tanks and settling tanks.
