With further reference to our letter of the 21st instant and yours of the 26th relating to the boss castings for Messrs. Burmeister & Wain's Yard No. 646, we beg to advise you that these castings have now been specially examined in company with the Owners' and Builders' Representatives, and it has been arranged to renew the Starboard Casting and to accept the Port Casting in which the defects were only very limited in extent.

The boss plates on the port side will be increased in thickness as per your letter, but the rivet area can be maintained without the extra row which the Owners' Representative does not desire.
