M. I duly received Mr. Hodgson's letters of the 31st ultimo and 2nd instant, together with a copy of a letter addressed to Messrs. Burmeister & Wain and copies of the plans, approved by him, of midship section, framing profile and decks of the Twin Screw Motor Ship, Yard No. 646, proposed to be built by them for the Blue Star Line, and the contents have been noted.

The scantlings and arrangements have been examined generally and found to be in order, but I think it well to state for Mr. Hodgson's information that it is observed that according to the deck plan the thicknesses proposed embody the Owners' extras, and in regard to this it is noted that the arrangement of these extras differs from that shewn on the plans of the sister vessels, copies of which have been sent to you.
