I am in receipt of Mr. Hodgson's letter of the 28th ultimo regarding an order received by Messrs. Burmeister & Wain for a large insulated motor ship intended for the Blue Star Line, and I note that this vessel will be similar, though slightly larger than Messrs. Harland & Wolff's Yard Nos. 957 & 958, the "EMPIRE STAR" and "SYDNEY STAR".

As desired, I am sending to your address to-day, under separate cover, nine hull plans of these two vessels, together with ten hull plans dealing with these two vessels and a sister ship "AUSTRALIA STAR", and shall be glad if you will return these plans to this Office after noting, per registered post.

At the same time I have to state that the plans and specification of insulation of the refrigerated cargo chambers for the new ship should be submitted to this Office for consideration.
