THE TANK STEAMER "OLIGARCH"
Port Said, Apr. 13. British tank
steamer Oligarch proceeded from this
port on Feb. 25 to Suez, where a cargo of
military explosives was loaded, prior to
vessel proceeding to sea to be scuttled.
The Oligarch sailed from Suez on Apr. 13
in tow of tug Peter C. Gallagher
for a predetermined point in the Red Sea
where the scuttling will be effected. The
tug will return to Suez with the members
of the crew of the Oligarch, on com-
pletion of the operation.
London, Apr. 30. Tank steamer
Oligarch was scuttled on Apr. 14.
