The vessel will be eligible for a record of LMC 9,43 when the pumping arrangements, air receivers, electrical equipment and steam pipes above 3" diameter have been examined and it will be appreciated if the Owners will endeavour to have these matters attended to as soon as possible. A further Donkey Boiler Survey will become due at the end of this month.

"TORRIDAL" In view of reports received from Bergen this vessel's class of 100A1 has been reinstated with Docking Date 2,43 and notations of M.S. 2,43, B.S. 2,41, S. 2,43. To entitle the vessel to a notation of S.S. No.3-2,43, the chain locker and anchors require to be examined and the chain cables ranged and examined, and it will be appreciated if you will request the Owners to endeavour to arrange for these outstanding items to be dealt with as soon as possible. Your reports of surveys held during the occupation are awaited but a further Boiler Survey is now due and propose you will state what arrangements are proposed to be made to be made for this inspection to be held.
