Dear Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 13th June last, respecting the donkey boiler built by Messrs. A/S Glommens mek. Verksted, Fredrikstad, for the m.s. "HELLESUND" we beg to acquaint you that the construction of this boiler was already well in hand when the plan was approved, and is now completed. There was no opportunity of taking check tests of the shell and end plates as these were ordered to accurate measurements but check tests have been taken of the furnace material. The test marks on the shell and end plates were, however, checked with the certificates.

The furnace has been heat treated, but not the cylindrical shell, all being completed at our first survey.

We shall, however, be glad to be informed whether there are any methods of heat treating the shell at this stage.

The workmanship appears very good, and the builders have made a large number of similar boilers to the requirements of other classification Societies.
