

Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 9th instant, with enclosures, relating to the question of the acceptance of a donkey boiler being constructed by Messrs. A/S. Glommens Mek. Verksted, Fredriksstad, to the order of Messrs. G.G. Amundsen A/S, Oslo, and intended for the s.s. "HELLESUND", the material of the boiler having been tested by the Surveyors to the Germanischer Lloyd.

The plan submitted has been examined, and I have to inform you that the scantlings of the boiler as shown thereon will be approved for a working pressure of 7 Kgs. per sq. cm. provided that on completion of the welding of the fittings and manhole compensating plate, and before riveting is commenced, the cylindrical shell of the boiler be efficiently heat treated.

Further, the results of the tests as shown on the Germanischer Lloyd Test Certificate are considered satisfactory, and in the circumstances the material in question will be accepted provided the same be examined and be found satisfactory, and check tests carried out on

portions cut from the material confirm the results shown
on the Test Certificate.
