M With reference to my letter of the 29th ultimo enclosing a copy of one received from Mr. Brewer, the Superintendent for the Owners of the steamer "BIKUNDERSON", I have to inform you that a further letter has now been received from Mr. Brewer stating that the vessel in question is the "EIKUNDASHUND", No. 14681 in the Register Book, built in Holland in 1916 and never classed with this Society.

No plans of the vessel are available in this Office, nor any information other than that recorded in the Register Book, and in the circumstances you should ascertain from the Owners' representative whether it is possible to obtain plans and forward them to this Office for examination, with a view to ascertaining for what class the ship is eligible.

In the meantime, in view of the vessel being opened up and in dry dock, you should proceed with the requirements of Section 48 of the Rules relating to ships not built under survey, and if it is not possible to obtain plans from any source it will be necessary for scantlings of the vessel to be taken by actual measurement at the ship, and particulars forwarded on First Entry Report forms, with as little delay as possible, for
