

This vessel is to be loaded with gas bombs and then scuttled and certain alterations have now been made for this purpose.

The bilge injection valve has been altered to allow flooding and a number of sluice valves fitted to the shell of the vessel in the holds.

It is submitted action be deferred pending the scuttling of the vessel.
