





Motor Ship "GEORGIAN", ex "FORDONIAN".


This vessel was built in 1912 and classed 100A1 "Awning deck with freeboard", "For Canadian Lake Service".

The vessel's class was withdrawn from the Register Book in August 1916, and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof.

A cablegram has now been received from the New York Surveyors requesting to be furnished with copies of the plans of midship section and longitudinal plan for the purposes of reclassification and alterations.

It is submitted that copies of the approved plans of midship section and profile and deck might be forwarded to the New York Surveyors, and they be informed that in order to render the vessel eligible for reclassification the full requirements of a Second Special Survey No.3 should be complied with, and the vessel placed in a thoroughly good and efficient condition to their entire satisfaction.
