Hatchside coaming stiffeners (wasted) require to be specially examined and dealt with at the next General Examination or Annual Freeboard Survey.

Buckled f'cle sheerstrake plates Nos. 2 & 3 (p.s) require to be dealt with at the Owners' convenience.

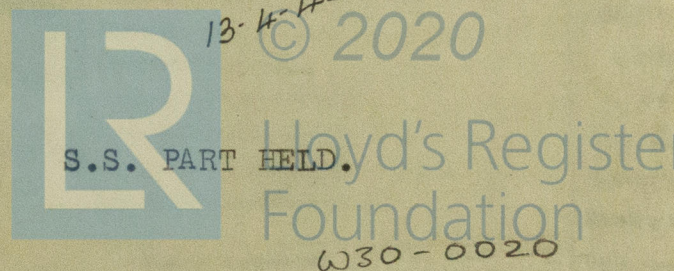
The NEWPORT MON. Surveyors report the vessel afloat and repairs, by welding, due to wear and tear, effected to plate edges and rivet heads and to some stem plating.

Shell plate No.2 from aft in 5th bellow sheer (p.s) found thinned and cracked, has been repaired by welding and doubling,

The buckled f'cle plating, as above, continues efficient.

The Special Survey has not been advanced.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to have her present records maintained.
