("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

This vessel, which was built in 1919 and was classed with the American Bureau, has now been acquired by British interests, and a considerable part of a Classification Survey S.S. No. 3 has been held and notations 100A1 (Classification contemplated) and Examined 7,40 were assigned by the American Committee on the 10th July last.

The MANCHESTER Surveyors now report the Classification Survey somewhat advanced.

Repairs are required to the masts and rigging.

It is stated arrangements have been made to deal with the topmast (mainmast) on the vessel's arrival at an American port. The New York Surveyors should be informed.
