A General Examination becomes due 11.46.

The class is subject to permanent repairs to indented shell plating etc. (p & s) and to boat deck planking etc. at the first convenient opportunity and to (a spare bower anchor being repaired and retested).

The LONDON Surveyors report the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom coated and minor repairs effected.

Temporary bunker in No.2 upper tween deck now removed and openings in tween deck bulkhead closed with steel plates.

It is submitted the vessel is worthy to remain as classed with record of docking survey 2.46 subject as above.
