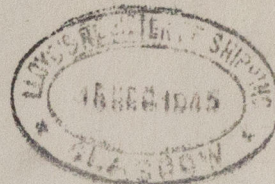

Steam Tanker "CORONDA".

In July last we entered into negotiations with Captain E.C. Shankland, of Mariners, Balfour Gardens, Folkstone, acting on behalf of a Brazilian Firm, for the sale of the above named vessel.

As the proposed terms of sale are that vessel is to be delivered to purchasers as she lies, we have been asked to ascertain the minimum repairs, if any, which would be essential to enable purchasers to secure a seaworthy certificate valid for the voyage to Brazil.
