In reply to your classing letter of the 19th instant, I beg to state that the butts of the shell plating at the turn of the bilge are in my opinion efficient until the next Special Survey, providing no further chafing takes place.

With reference to the close ceiling, the whole of this was removed from the tank tops and at the bilges, with the exception of the cross bunker space and lower side bunkers which still require to be examined as part of the work to complete the Special Survey as stated in the report. No. 3 Double Bottom tank requires to be examined internally in its entirety.
