Nature of Survey

It is submitted before this case receives the consideration of the Committee the Surveyors should be requested to state, in view of their recommendation that the entry in the Special Reasons List be now deleted, whether the butts of the shell plating at the turn of the bilge are in their opinion efficient until ^{the} next Special Survey.

The Surveyors should also be requested to state whether the whole of the close ceiling at the bilges has been lifted and whether No. 3 double bottom tank has been examined clear of the cross bunker.
