Referring to our letter to your Leith Office, dated 25th August, regarding a proposal to convert the above vessel and make it suitable for carrying Whale Oil in bulk, we now enclose plan in duplicate of new centre line bulkhead and two new transverse bulkheads.

We shall be pleased to know as early as is convenient if this plan has your approval. With regard to the existing transverse bulkheads, we presume that these have been built to rule and we shall be obliged if you will indicate what additional stiffening is required.

The class of oil to be carried is Whale Oil with Specific Gravity of .923.

The early attention will help us greatly, as tenders have to be posted end of next week.
