successfully withstood a tensile stress of 12 tons.

One length of 44'-6" of 7/8" diameter gipsy chain,
successfully withstood a tensile stress of 9-1/8 tons.

The two lengths of chain were stamped L.R. H.89,12,39,12 tons.

One length of chain was stamped L.R. H.89, 12,39, 9-1/8 tons.
