With reference to your letter of the 27th instant relating to the Trawler which will be designated 1210, as a duplicate of the "AKITA", No. 1201, built by Messrs. Cochrane & Sons Ltd., for Messrs. Neale & West Ltd., we beg to advise you that this vessel is to be constructed from the plans of No. 1201, and we shall be glad if you will kindly forward the plans for our guidance with the new number of the vessel.

The frames for this vessel will be 5 x 3 x .4 angles instead of $4\frac{1}{2}$ x 3 x .4 angles, and the beams will be 6 x 3 x .44 ordinary angles instead of 5 x 3 x .40 bulb angles.
