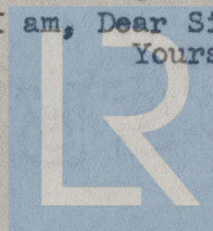
I should add that the plan has only been considered in respect of the scantlings of the pillars. It has, however, been necessary to amend these in several instances on account of the increased loads to be carried compared with the sister vessels, and also, in the case of some of the tween deck pillars, on account of the reduced breadth of the pillars.

I have also to inform you, with regard to the final paragraph of Mr. Edgar's letter, that, with the diaphragms which are proposed to be fitted, it is considered that the thickness of the plates forming the pillars as shown and amended on the plan is such as could be approved.

The duplicate copy of the plan is being retained.
