With reference to your letter of the 11th inst. approving a plan of midship section for the above vessel, information has been received from the Builders this morning, that it is now proposed to fit a watertight bulkhead extending to the 2nd deck in the fore body on frame 117.

This will also affect the plan of framing etc. forwarded with my letter of the 12th instant.

It is observed from your letter of the 11th inst. above referred to, that compensation has been indicated in the form of an increase to the strength of the framing in No. 2 hold for the omission of the bulkhead which is now to be fitted, and as at the present time we are not in receipt of the plans, it is requested, if this compensation is not clearly indicated as such but is merged in the General frame scantlings, that we be advised by letter as soon as possible by what amount the scantlings may be reduced.
