

EXTRACT FROM AFFIDAVIT SWORN ON 30TH DECEMBER, 1931, BY A. MARINI,
2ND OFFICER, and G. ANDREATTA, CHIEF ENGINEER, OF THE S.S.

"ALABAMA", BEFORE THE NOTARY, DR. A. FASCE.

We declare that, while the vessel was at Philadelphia, where she arrived on the 7th March, 1931, we were present when the Surveyors, Messrs. White, Silleman, Buchanan, came on board to ascertain the damage suffered owing to the cyclone met after leaving Baytown on the 4th March, and successive days, and that on that occasion Captain Di Gioia drew the attention of the said Surveyors to the undulations on deck, telling them that the undulations were caused by the cyclone.
