We request that the Committee of Lloyd's Register will instruct Society's Surveyors to survey 2 Diesel Marine Engines 6S38 No.6001 and 7 each of 780 BHP at 170 rpm. during construction and witness the necessary tests on material in accordance with your rules with a view the notation * L.M.C. being assigned.

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees the Surveyors' services, in addition to the actual travelling and other expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connexion therewith.

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations Lloyd's Register of Shipping, which provide that:-
